PRELIMINARY PROPOSALS

During these two days of work, the representatives of the Canadian and Mexican Governments have noted the issues of interest to the countries.

Appart from the formal report we will present to the Regional Consultation Group on Migration, we would like to share with you some issues we find particularly relevant.

1. The need to reinforce the binational and regional cooperation links and develop this effort into concrete activities.
2. The importance of promoting the coordination between Civil Society Organizations and Governments to reach common agreements that will develop into public policies and joint actions.
3. The interest of taking advantage of the existing binational and cross-border experiences and good practices.
4. The convenience of evaluating the possible creation of a health workgroup that will report its actions to the Consular Protection Network of the Regional Conference on Migration.
